

Johnson County Sunday Evening Net Script

Preamble

QST, QST, QST. Calling the Johnson County Sunday Evening Net. This is _____, net control for this evening. My name is _____ and I am located in _____.

This net meets every Sunday evening at 7:30 p.m. local time on the WØJV repeater in Iowa City.

This is an informal net and we encourage participants to share their ham radio news. This is, however, a directed net, so please direct all communications through net control.

When checking in, please clearly give the information requested. It is not necessary to give the net control station's callsign, nor to indicate whether or not you have traffic. Those with emergency traffic may break in at any time by using the words "break" or "break emergency" along with their callsign.

Check-ins

To begin check-ins, I first call the president of the Iowa City Amateur Radio Club and representatives of other organizations with **official** traffic. Please give your callsign, name, QTH, and official title.

[Record and acknowledge each station, returning to each in turn for their traffic.]

Are there any stations with **formal** message traffic? Please give your callsign, name, and QTH.

[Record and acknowledge each station, returning to each in turn for their traffic.]

We will now take check-ins from all other stations **with traffic** for the net not previously reported. Please give your callsign, name, and QTH.

[Record and acknowledge each station, returning to each in turn for their traffic, repeating until no more check-ins with traffic.]

This is _____, with the Johnson County Sunday Evening Net. We will now take check-ins from stations who do **not** have traffic for the net. Please give your callsign, name, and QTH.

[Record and acknowledge each station, repeating until no more check-ins.]

Before I summarize traffic, are there any late check-ins with or without traffic? Please give your callsign, name, and QTH and indicate whether you have traffic.

[Record and acknowledge each station, returning to those who have traffic.]

I will now summarize the traffic...

[Summarize (rather than repeat) traffic.]

Are there any corrections or additions to any of the traffic?

[Listen for corrections or additions...]
